Greetings: Interested in learning about a faire from the inside? We are looking for enthusiastic people of all ages to help create the magic that is the Cain's Crossing Renaissance Faire! Volunteering is a wonderful way to meet new people and give back to the community. We have volunteer opportunities in a variety of areas, skilled and unskilled. Volunteers assisting during the Faire wear Renaissance clothing; those who assist before or after do not.

Some of the many Volunteer jobs available:

Set-up/ Teardown

Many hands make light work. Many jobs to fill - assemble structures or fences, hang burlap or signs, move wood or hay bales, etc. Positions start Friday before the faire and include post-faire time on Sunday and Monday.

Poster Hanging

Assist hanging event posters in various regional areas in the weeks prior to the faire. Volunteers from Sacramento, Rocklin, Loomis, Roseville, Colfax, Foresthill, Truckee and Tahoe are especially needed.

Runners

During the faire runners are needed to do "on call "errands.

Parking

Direct participants and visitors to designated parking areas.

Volunteer Registration

Sign-in volunteers and guide them where to go.

Security

Patrol grounds and help keep a watchful eye.

Children's Glen

Assist in entertaining the kids. Activities include games, arts, songs, etc. This is not childcare, parents must be present.

CAIN'S CROSSING RENAISSANCE FAIRE FAIRE CONDUCT AND VOLUNTEERS

1. All volunteers must be in period Elizabethan costume during the operating hours of faire. At a minimum, all costumes should comply with the CIRGA costume guidelines and must include shirts, shoes and underclothes. No cross dressing, horns, whips or other flogging implements. This faire is a benefit for children and your costume should be a reflection of that.
2. Notes will be held at 9:00 AM on Saturday and Sunday. A representative from each group must attend and relay Notes to the rest of your group. Scheduling changes, security issues and teardown instructions will be made at Notes.
3. Minors under 21 years of age are prohibited from consuming, purchasing, or handling alcoholic beverages. Controlled substances are strictly prohibited on the faire site and surrounding environs. Anyone caught with such substances will be turned over to the authorities and denied readmission to the faire. Drunken, unruly or lewd behavior will result in immediate removal from faire grounds.
4. No pets are allowed at faire. The only animals allowed are working ones, such as seeing-eye dogs or those integral to a show. Anyone bringing an unauthorized animal onsite will be ejected from the faire along with the animal. Any animal bites will be reported to Animal Control. If you have an animal that is essential for your show, you must provide proof of liability insurance for your animal. Contact the faire director before arriving with your pet.
5. Auburn Regional Park and Cain's Crossing Renaissance Faire is a non-smoking site. Cigarette smoking is prohibited except in specified smoking areas outside the gates. Please refrain from smoking in view of patrons.
6. Off-duty police officers will provide security; but the faire is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Please secure your possessions.
7. No minors will be allowed to volunteer without a signed parent's treatment consent permission form with the volunteer coordinator.
8. Volunteers are responsible for their group and for making sure their staff are familiar with these rules and regulations.
9. To enter the faire via gate list is to agree to abide by these rules and regulations.

**CAIN'S CROSSING RENAISSANCE FAIRE
PARTICIPANT/VOLUNTEER WAIVER**

1. If required of me, I will enroll in the CAIN'S CROSSING Workshop and participate in the workshops and seminars required of me.
2. I understand that I am participating as a volunteer in a performing arts-living history program of CAIN'S CROSSING RENAISSANCE FAIRE (herein after referred to as "The Faire") and at no time during my volunteer participation shall I: (a) be deemed to be an employee or an agent of the Faire, (b) be entitled to any remuneration of any kind or (c) be entitled to any insurance benefits of any kind or nature normally attributable to employment. Further, it is mutually agreed that at all times relevant herein, I shall be deemed a volunteer.
3. I understand and agree there are inherent risks of bodily injury or harm related to participating in the Faire. I expressly agree to assume all such risks, of whatever kind or nature, whether known or unknown at the time, and agree to hold CAIN'S CROSSING, Inc., the Faire, its directors, employees, agents, associates harmless and indemnify and defend them from any and all damages resulting from such risks, regardless of the cause or fault of any such damage and/or injury.
4. I agree that when present at the Faire during operating hours I shall: (a) remain in an approved costume, hairstyle, make-up, and props, (b) refrain from displaying modern items to patrons, including but not limited to electronic devices, cell phones, modern beverage containers, watches, sunglasses, nail polish, body piercings, and cigarettes, (c) refrain from the consumption of alcoholic beverages during faire hours, and (d) when audible to patrons, attempt to speak in a dialect suggestive of a person from the 16th Century. I further agree that whenever I am present on or near the Faire site, (e) I shall adhere to all the Faire rules, regulations, policies, and procedures, as well as all federal, state, and local laws and that my participation may be terminated if it is believed that I am in violation of any Fair's policies or federal, state, or local law, or that I am engaging in any behavior which could prove injurious to myself, to others, or security of the Fair, or damaging to the morale of the Faire. (f) I agree to surrender my pass/wristband immediately upon the request of any official representative of the Faire Management, or security personnel.
5. I hereby give my consent to the Faire for the use of my name, biography, image, recorded in any print, photographic, electronic or digital medium in connection with the Faire. CAIN'S CROSSING, Inc. may freely use such information and images for a period not to exceed one hundred (100) years from date of signature.
